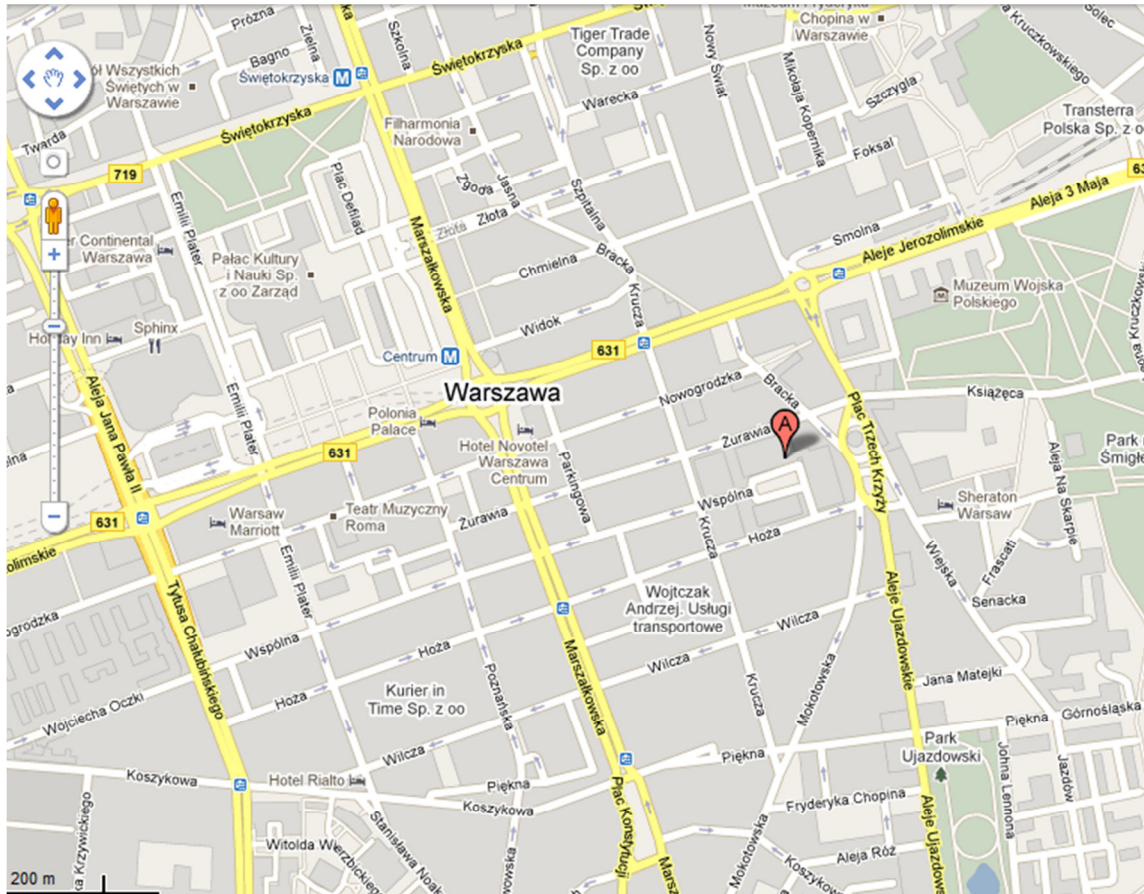


Draft Agenda for the ESPON INTERSTRAT in Warsaw

INTERACTIVE ACTIVITIES

11.00: **Brain storming** „What makes a good ITDS?“ „How to understand territorial dimension?“

Participants will be divided into 5 thematic groups:

- General: ECPs, experts [ENG]
- Good governance and security [PL]
- Human capital, social capital, innovation [PL]
- Regional, urban and rural development [PL]
- Transport, energy, environment [PL]

Each group will receive a sheet of paper and will brainstorm and generate most important ideas concerning two main questions. At the end speakers of each group will present results on the forum. They will be discussed.

12.00: **Quiz on European Territorial Development:** Poland in European context. [PL]

Participants will be divided into two competing teams and will answer questions about Poland based on ESPON results and typologies. Answering will include analyzing ESPON maps.

13.15: **World Café** – what type of knowledge is necessary to include territorial dimension in ITDS? What indicators might be useful in this proces? What do ESPON scenarios say about Polish territory?

Participants will be divided into 5 groups by 5 different tables.

- General (ECPs) [ENG]
- Good governance and security [PL]
- Human capital, social capital, innovation [PL]
- Regional, urban and rural developement [PL]
- Transport, energy, environment [PL]

ECPs will deliberate by one table on general issues. Other 4 table will include and expert-rapporteur. Each group will have 15-20 minutes for generating as many ideas as possible and they will be written down on large sheets of papers by each tables. Rapporteur is will moderate discussion and note the ideas. After one session participants will change tables 3 times so that everyone will have a chance to sit at each thematic table. Participants will be asked to cooperate in various constellations. At the end rapporteurs will present the results from each table.

15.00: **Silent brainstorming.** How to include territorial dimension in ITDS? In which thematic areas and in which governance levels ESPON results might be useful? How to make ESPON more useful for practitioner and stakeholders?

The second round of conclusions they will be asked to share their experience and feelings about the workshop. Learning diaries shall be photocopied and archived by the organsiser.
